## Year 6 PGL Residential - Last Minute Reminders

Just a few last-minute reminders before we set off for our PGL adventure.

- Please can all children be in school at the usual time, dressed comfortably for travel (no school uniform).
- The coach is scheduled to leave school at 2:00pm on Monday and you are very welcome to wave your children off, if you are available. We will update you on Friday afternoon of our expected time of arrival back at school, it is currently scheduled for 3:30pm however traffic often causes short delays.
- We will be eating lunch as usual before we travel. Please can you provide a 'disposable' packed lunch (no plastic Tupperware-style containers) for those not having school dinners.
- Please ensure that you provide suitable clothing as listed in the PGL guidelines, to avoid injury when the children access the harnesses etc.
- Please refer to the Kit List that was sent/handed to you and your child. PGL advise that children bring a minimum of 2 towels and 2 pairs of trainers, as one of the activities will be in the water.
- Please provide bedding and a pillow for your child as they are not provided (a fitted sheet IS provided). Sleeping bags are preferable as the children will have to carry their items from the coach to their cabins themselves. No oversized suitcases please!
- Please ensure that your child has at least 1 large plastic bag/bin bag in their case, to store wet clothes and protect dry ones.
- Electronic equipment, smart watches and mobile phones are strictly not allowed.
- Each day an update will be posted to you by email. Please keep your eye out for these!
