In the past, Arunside School has worked with 'Perform', who have provided free drama workshops for our children and consequently we like to support their promotions. They will be hosting a new festival called Perform in the Park in central London this summer, where you and your children can enjoy a live theatre show in a 500-seat air-conditioned theatre followed by the delights of Coram's Fields. The six-week festival includes four fantastic productions for children with shows running daily from 22 July to 28 August. The line-up includes:

- · Elephant and Piggie's "We are in a Play!" based on Mo Willems' best-selling books
- · Mermaids & Pirates Perform's swashbuckling summer themed show for 4-11s
