

# Arunside Announcements Week Commencing Monday 11th September 2023

It was lovely to welcome the children back into school last week and to hear about the exciting things they got up to in the holidays. We hope they are looking forward to the autumn term and that as parents you will find our weekly Arunside Announcements a useful planning tool and that the information contained enables you to support the school.

#### **Procedures for the Start of the School Day**

To ease congestion on the main road at the start of the day, we will continue to allow those Year 5 and 6 pupils who walk or cycle independently to school and arrive at 8.30am to wait on the ball court from 8.30am - 8.35am. They will be called down from the main gates to do this by the member of staff on duty at the start of the day.

The gates will then open from 8.35am, at the start of the school day, for all children in Years 1-4 and the member of staff on gate duty will welcome the children down at this time. Please come down through the double gates in the centre of the car park and on to the ball court, to allow a one-way system back out through the smaller playground side gate for any parents and carers leaving after drop off. We thank you for your co-operation with this.

### **After School Clubs**
