#### **Easter Holiday and Food**

Families eligible for Free School Meals (FSM) will be entitled to a £15.00 voucher per FSM child, per week during the Easter holidays. These will shortly be dispatched in the usual way.

We also remind parents that bookings for the <u>Easter HAF Programme</u> are open. Places are available at a range of different holiday clubs across the county for children receiving benefits related FSM. Each session includes a free nutritious meal, and every eligible child can attend up to 4 sessions. For children who are not eligible for FSMs, but whose families need urgent support with food in West Sussex, the Community Hubs will be operating.
