


### Curriculum

Our Autumn topic is Mountains and Rivers. Our Spring topic is Ancient Rome. Our Summer topics are Ancient Greece and Horsham.

#### Local Walks – Summer Term


- As part of our Horsham topic, we will carry out two local walks.

- The children will get to experience staying away from home and lots of outdoor adventurous activities.




#### Homework
