<p><b>Spelling tests</b></p> <p>Spelling tests will be completed weekly on a Friday. Children will be given a spelling list for each half term that they can keep at home. The children need to wear the school PE kit to school on these days. Please send your child to school in their PE kits which are suitable for the weather that day.
