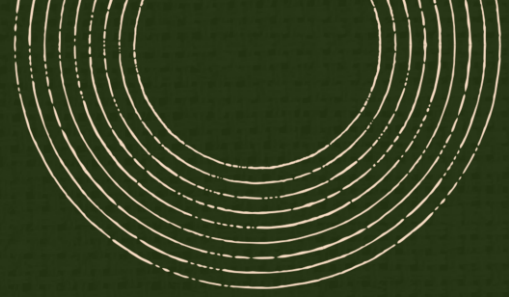

What to bring...

- On Monday, send your child in wearing forest school clothes
- If the weather isn't wet on Monday morning, please ensure wet weather clothes are packed in case the weather changes
- Bring one bag that your child can carry or pull along themselves
- Please don't send your child with electronics or phones – these will be confiscated
- A small digital clock or nightlight if wanted
- You may want to send your child with a book and/or a cuddly toy for bedtime



Kit List

Lodge Hill Example Kit List

- Towel
- Wash bag (soap, flannel, toothbrush, toothpaste)
- Pyjamas
- Socks/underwear
- T-shirts (long and short sleeved)
- Trousers (tracksuit bottoms/jeans)
- A pair of trainers/boots (that can get muddy)
- A pair of indoor shoes
- Waterproof jacket
- Jumpers/Hoodies/Fleeces
- Water bottle
- Sleeping bag
- Pillow/Pillowcase



Sleeping arrangements

- All children put down the names of three people they wanted to be with
- We will ensure that every child has at least one of their choices
- The children will find out who they are sharing with on arrival
- The doors will be labelled so the children know where everyone is
- There will be support from a member of staff whenever they need it throughout the night
- Please let us know if your child has any night time issues e.g. bedwetting, which will of course be dealt with discreetly



Meals and food

- Lodge hill have been given information on any allergies your child has and will provide appropriate alternatives where necessary
- Please ensure that the office have up to date information about your children's medical needs and allergies
- You will need to send your child in on Monday with a packed lunch and a snack for when they arrive
- Monday meals provided: afternoon tea, dinner
- Tuesday meals provided: breakfast, lunch
- Please don't send extra snacks/sweets/crisps, unless previously agreed with the class teacher
