Lent is the time of year when **Christians** prepare for **Easter**. Lent begins in February or March, depending on the date of Easter. The word Lent comes from an older English word meaning "springtime" Easter services are held on Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday.

Christians believe that it was God's plan that Jesus was to suffer death in this way to show that people can be forgiven and have a fresh start. Jesus forgave the thief and bystanders at his crucifixion.

Many Christians will go regularly to church to share in communion in memory of the death and resurrection of Christ.

Info

Crucifixion was a common punishment for certain crimes in Jesus' times. The Bible says Jesus was put to death along with two thieves.

Jesus fulfilled many prophecies from the Old Testament throughout his life, but especially over Holy Week. These allowed his disciples, who would have known these verses, to have even more belief that he was the long-awaited Messiah
