Key Vocabulary	
Map	A drawing of a town, a country or the world. Maps show you where roads, mountains and rivers are.
Globe	A ball/sphere with a map of the whole world.
Atlas	A book of maps.
Weather	The conditions you might notice when outside.
Country	A land with its own people and laws.
Continent	One of the 7 very large areas of land in the world.
Key	Map keys are boxes in the corner of the map. The information they give you is essential to understanding the map.
Sketch Map	a roughly drawn map that shows only basic details
Aerial View	The word aerial means from above. When we look at something from above we call this an 'aerial view'
Ordnance Survey (OS)	Ordnance Survey (OS) is Great Britain's national mapping agency.
compass	 <p>A compass is a device that shows the cardinal directions used for navigation and geographic orientation.</p>
Physical features	Include: beach, cliff, coast, forest, hill, mountain, sea, ocean, river, soil, valley, vegetation, season and weather.
Human Features	Include: city, town, village, factory, farm, house, office, port, harbour and shop.

The town is 31 miles south south-west of London, 18.5 miles north-west of Brighton and 26 miles north-east of the county town of Chichester.
