Easy Lunch – If you have not already booked your Easy Lunch meals for the next half term we would like to let you know that the deadline for meals that will be eaten on Monday 24th February is midnight on Saturday 15th February. You will need to book via the www.theeasylunchcompany.co.uk website.

Easy Lunch will be proving Pancakes for pudding on Tuesday 4th March in celebration of Shrove Tuesday, (Pancake Day!) These will be served with golden syrup (registered special diets will be catered for accordingly).

Headteacher Cover – Mrs Jagger has been asked to cover the headteacher role for a struggling school that currently has no leadership. The agreement is that Mrs Jagger will not be onsite threedays a week at Arunside during the next half term. This arrangement will be in place for approximately 2-6weeks and during the cover period, Mrs Hadden will be acting headteacher for Arunside, supported by the our leadership team.

Year 5 – Oak Class – Swimming - We remind parents that the second block of swimming lessons for Oak class resumes on Monday 3rd March (with the final session being on Monday 31th March).

The children walk to and from the pool regardless of whether or not they are taking part in the arranged lessons and may be picked up straight from the Pavilions at 3:15pm. However, parents are advised that we will be unable to wait for anyone who might be running late as we need to return the other children back to school for 3.50pm. We will also be unable to release any child during our walk back.

Children will need to bring a small bag containing a swimming costume (not bikini), a towel, a water bottle and a swimming hat in order to comply with pool's regulations. Children are not permitted to wear jewelry and long hair must be tied back before entering the pool.
