Jewellery Reminder - Children are not allowed to wear items of jewellery at school, although discretion is given to respect religious observance provided prior permission has been given by the headteacher. The school strongly discourages ear-piercing but those children who have their ears pierced during a school year will be permitted to wear ear-studs for the first six-weeks after piercing provided these are worn flat to the ear. For health and safety reasons, all jewellery, including earrings, must be removed before PE lessons and the school cannot be held responsible for any loss or accidental damaged incurred to these items. Earrings worn for piercings that are less that six-weeks old must be covered by a plaster/ micro-porous tape (provided by parents) for all PE lessons.
