

#### Catkins Nursery After School & Holiday Club

Catkins Nursery in Three Acres, RH12 1RS, (just off Blackbridge Lane), is a children's nursery offering full day care for children aged 2-5years. Catkins is OFSTED registered and rated as an 'Outstanding' setting (February 2024), having achieved a previous 'Outstanding' outcome, (March 2018)

From September 2024 we have started offering an after-school club for children attending Arunside Primary School and St John's Catholic Primary School. We will also offer a 'Holiday Club' for children attending any local school, offering day or sessional care. Both options are for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children only.

Catkins Nursery staff will collect children from both schools and walk them back to nursery where they will join the nursery children for the rest of the afternoon up to 5.50pm.

The after-school children will settle in, wash hands and then have a circle time/story and will join with the nursery children for a substantial tea. Catkins prides itself on its' high-quality freshly made, nutritional food and varied menu and tea is a filling meal which means when you get home the children won't require a tea. 

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Tea can range from soups, cheese & ham muffins, quesadillas, pasta dishes, fish finger sandwiches, baked potatoes, sandwiches etc together with crudités, fruit platters, cake or yoghurts, water or milk etc with all dietary requirements or allergies catered for.

Children can then have 'down time' with free play activities and games or outside play in our fabulous nursery. We have a wide range of toys and equipment for

the children to choose from. School holiday care can also be arranged, subject to availability from 8am-5.50pm, or half terms and holidays for a combination of session/days.



Our staff are experienced, and most are trained to Level 3 or above in Early Years. All staff hold First Aid, CP, Food Hygiene, Health & Safety training as well as curriculum courses accessed throughout the year.

Our nursery runs with children aged 2-5years together at present, with all children in the same room, sometimes 'peeling off' for specific activities suitable to age/stage, eg stories or small construction toys such as Lego. Siblings can join together at the end of the day prior to collection if they wish to. This new service will complement our existing provision as 'family tiered grouping' means older children also help the younger ones and this enriches the experience for all.

Emphasis is on a homely atmosphere in a safe & fun purpose-built setting where children can relax after a hard day at school!

We are limiting the number of school children's spaces per day in the first instance to five, as we introduce this new service.

There is a £50 registration fee (non-refundable), and a place is £20 per day inclusive of collection from school and the 4pm substantial 'high tea' & drinks. Fees are paid half termly in advance and adhoc extra sessions may be booked subject to availability.

ZigZag Out of School Clubs (Horsham) are Otsted-registered breakfast and after school clubs during term-time (from 7.30am up to 6.00pm) for children from Reception up to Year 6. We reflect, value and serve the families and community at Arunside Primary School, providing a nurturing and fun place for your child{ren}. Our caring staff are highly experienced in childcare, playwork and safeguarding; we encourage children's individuality and collaboration and liaise closely with families to provide feedback about each child's time with us. Kindness, inclusion and enjoyment are at the heart of all we do, promoting selfconfidence and social skills while children participate in creative and fun activities, independently or with friends, inside and outdoors. We aim to ensure each child's care and learning needs are supported and that the children we care for really enjoy their time with us, before and after school.

ZigZag Breakfast Club is a relaxed, creative and welcoming environment. We are based in the beautiful, big hall at Arunside Primary School. Before school, our Breakfast Club offers valuable time and space for children to eat, relax and play ahead of the school day. We are open from 7,30am, Monday to Friday, during ferm time for children from Reception up to Year 6, providing a variety of healthy and tasty breakfast options, catering for dietary requirements and preferences (arrive by 8.15 to have time to eat without rushing! Children also enjoy a choice of free-play and activities such as arts & crafts, imaginative play, construction, reading, cars, animals, writing, drawing, skipping and various games. We then take the children to their respective classroom meeting areas in time for the start of their school day.

ZigZag After School Club has a 'positive play' ethos and sessions are a mix of free-play, planned activities and special projects. After School Club is available during school term-time, Monday to Friday. We are based at ZigZag/Scout Hut (just up the road on Hills Farm Lane) up to 6.00pm. After the school day, children welcome quality time to relax, unwind and play freely and imaginatively at their own pace. We collect children from their classrooms after school and have sole-use of our large, colourful playrooms at the hut, enjoying the outdoor playground and garden as well. We are also joined by children from \$t John's on some afternoons. A selection of healthy snacks and refreshments is provided daily, catering for various dietary requirements and preferences. Our wonderful staff provide a caring and stimulating environment for children from Reception up to Year 6. We offer a variety of free-play opportunity and an assortment of activities and resources, including creative arts & crafts, baking, clay-modelling, gardening, den-building, dressing up & imaginative play, construction, Lego & K'nex, homework club, cosy chill-out area, themed projects, reading, drawing, writing, painting, dancing, trampolining, ball sports and a range of calming or energetic games (including, sand, mud and water... so sometimes a bit messyl)
