








Year 6 Evacuation Day

Keep Gate Shut

Parents **must not** enter the school building without signing in at the office and collecting a visitor lanyard unless they have been invited to Family Reading or a parent assembly / concert. For safeguarding reasons we also insist that the pedestrian gate is not left open by visitors between the hours of 8.50am and 3.20pm. Staff members are no longer on gate duty at this time.

School Clubs Reminder

Please remember to collect your children from the correct location. If the club your child attends is run by a school teacher in a classroom please collect them from the school playground, not the foyer. **The foyer is for externally-led clubs only.**

It is your responsibility to ensure that your chosen tutors have the relevant qualifications in the chosen subject area, safeguarding experience, DBS checks and insurances to safely and accurately educate and supervise your children.

The class that brings in the most weight in batteries will be crowned the most ECO-LOGICAL CLASS and will win a spectacular...




