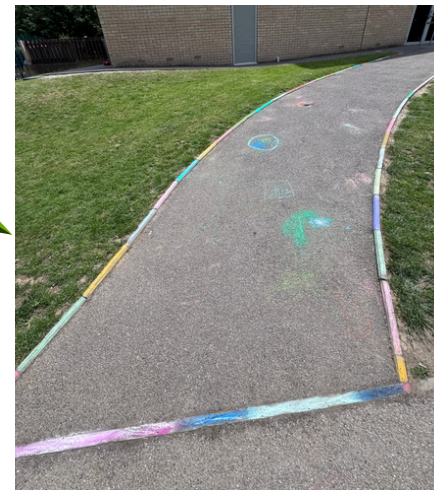

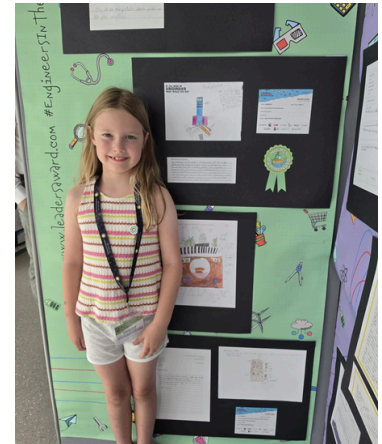
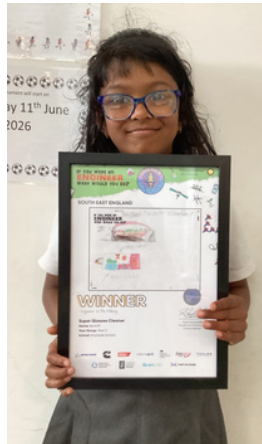
A huge thank you to Dave, Megan, and everyone at Kingdom Faith for welcoming us so warmly. It was a wonderful trip for everyone involved!



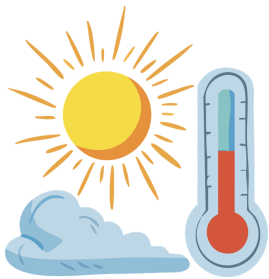
Engineering Awards in Canterbury

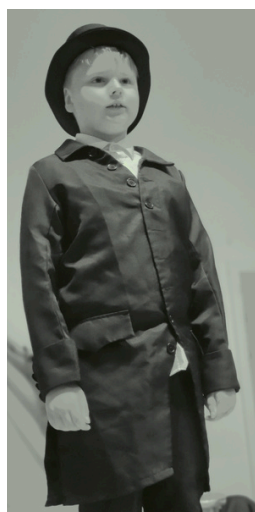


Oliver with a Twist



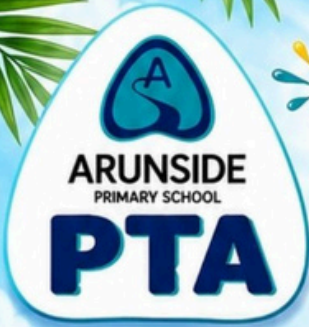
