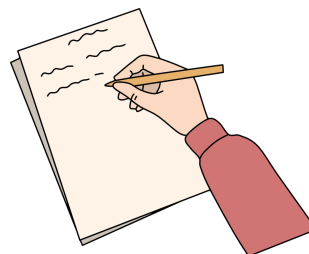

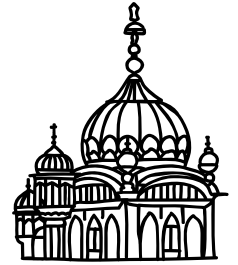
PSHE Scheme Presentation

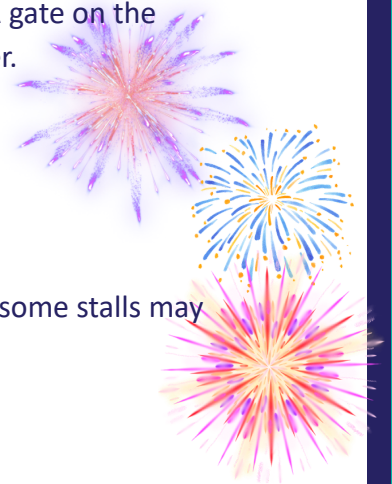
